









Year 3 Autumn term homework grid

Design a piece of cave art using materials of your choice. i.e. paint, chalk, crayon.</p>	<p>Stone Age people build shelters to live in using materials they had gathered. Gather some natural materials and build a model shelter.</p>	<p>Make a shadow puppet.</p>
