



Nursery Parents Information Sheet Summer 1

In Literacy we will:

- Continue Phase One Phonics which includes: Environmental Sounds, Body Percussion, Rhythm & Rhyme, Alliteration and Voice Sounds using Little Wandle
- Use Squiggle to mark straight lines, letter S and number 8
- Write some or all of our names
- Use print and letter knowledge in writing
- Write some letters accurately

In Maths, we will:

- Subitise small numbers
- Recognise, order and count numbers 1 - 5
- Count beyond 5
- Sort, match and compare
- Use vocabulary relating to size (tall/short)
- Add two groups together

In Understanding of the World we will:

- Talk about what we see, using a wide range of vocabulary
- Explore how things work
- Plant seeds and care for growing plants
- Use all our senses in hands-on exploration using natural materials
- Understand the key features of the life cycle of a **plant** and an **animal**

In Personal, Social and Emotional Development we will:

- Look at the question, 'What makes a good helper and who helps us?'
