English

Can you make a rainforest out of a shoe box/ old box and discuss the many reasons why trees are so important?



Maths

Can you bake a cake and practise splitting it into halves and quarters, recognising how many parts the whole needs to be split into for each?



Art

Can you make an animal sculpture at home?



Science

Choose an animal from an vertebrate family and create a fact file about it! E.g. a snake from the reptile group, what features make them belong to this group?



PE

Draw a simple map of a room in your house identifying key landmarks e.g. table, sofa, tree, swing. Hide 3-5 objects around these landmarks. Follow the directions using the landmarks to find the treasure.



Geography

If you are visiting a coast, can you talk about what happens to rocks when they are exposed to wind/ water? Can you see any examples?



PSHE

Can you look at baby pictures with a family member and discuss how you are different now? E.g. What changes have happened to my body? (e.g., growing taller, stronger muscles).



Music

Can you listen to a short piece of Samba music (find one online). Discuss: What instruments can you hear? (Drums, whistles, shakers?) How does the music make you feel? (Happy, excited, like dancing?)
