Welcome to the final term! Here is what we will be getting up to:

Maths

We are looking at mass and capacity, fractions, money and time. For time, we will be learning how to tell the time to 5 minutes, to the minute as well as continuing with quarter past, half past and quarter to.

English

We will be reading *The Wild Robot* by Peter Brown and we will use this to write a narrative and instructions. We will look at the work of Harold Monroe for our poetry unit.

Reading

We are continuing our fluency lessons with the Little Wandle books.

Science

This term, we will be focusing on plants. We will specifically be looking at the different flowering parts of a plant and their purposes.

Geography

We are exploring rainforests with a specific focus on South America.

Art
