Book Swap Hut

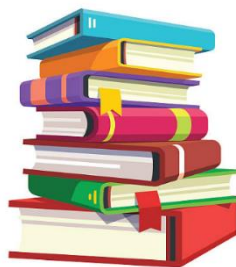
You may have been wondering what the purpose of the blue shed was at the front of school...were we selling eggs from it? Was it a gardening shed?

Summer Fair



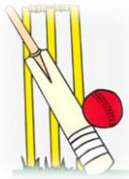
Thank you for all your support for making this year's summer fair such a fantastic event – whether donating, volunteering, spending or attending - every little bit goes towards making it a super family occasion.

This year the fair made an unbelievable **£3132**

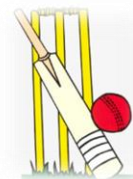
